## NCPA Enhanced Services Boot Camp

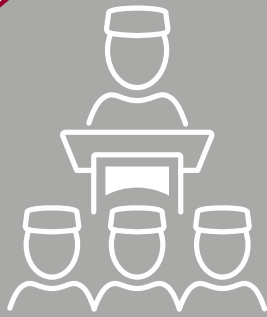
