



Summary of ages and vaccinations Arkansas pharmacists can provide

Medication	Patient Age	Protocol or Rx Only
Influenza Vaccine	7 years and older	Protocol or Rx
All other immunizations / vaccinations (flu, zoster, tetanus, pertussis, etc.)	18 years and older	Protocol or Rx
All other Immunizations	7 to 17 years old	Rx Only
Other Medications*	7 and older	Rx Only

*Other classes of medications Arkansas pharmacists can administer

- Allergy Medications
- Vitamins
- Minerals
- Anti-hyperglycemics
- Anti-nausea

Please note pharmacists are not permitted to administer medications that fall outside of these classes. Hormones such as testosterone or medroxyprogesterone CANNOT be administered by a pharmacist even if the patient has a prescription that states, "To be administered at pharmacy."
